## The Risk

If members of the public can gain ready access to our sites there is a risk they could have an accident and be seriously injured or even killed. Remember, a building site looks like an attractive play ground to a child or youth! We also need to consider the risks we create to members of the public from our activities and put in place measures to protect them.



## Responsibilities

Site security and protection of the public is ultimately the responsibility of site management but you have your part to play in ensuring a safe site:

## **Site Security**

- Ensure that all gates are closed behind you, pedestrian and vehicle.
- Do not open any Herras fencing unless you have been given uthorisation by the site management.
- If Herras fencing has been opened up, it must NEVER be left unattended.
- Fencing that has been opened up must be closed as soon as possible and before the site closes.
- If you see open Herras fencing left open or fencing that has not been secured tell site management immediately.
- If you see any unauthorised persons on site, ask them to stay where they are and contact site management to speak with them.
- All excavations must be fenced off, inside and outside of site boundaries.
- · Offsite works must be strictly supervised.
- Where material can fall outside of site the site boundary from a scaffold, a scaffold fan should be erected.
- Do not leave tools and materials unattended outside of the site boundary, or where untrained persons, can access them.
- Only park your van or car in authorised areas.
- Do not leave any plant or machines unattended outside of site boundaries.
- Always ensure that plant and machines are locked and keys kept securly away from the vehicle when not in use.
- Report any potential trip hazards that you see to the site management.
- · Remove any waste as you work and at the end of each day.
- Any materials that must be left outside of the site boundary overnight, must be fenced off with Herras fencing.
- If you are operating Plant outside of site give way to the public, you may also require a Banks
